IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT LMS 8TH GRADE PROMOTION ACTIVITIES

Dear Eighth Grade Families,

This letter contains information about the special activities and events that have been planned as a culmination of your child's eighth grade year. Eligibility requirements, as well as specific dates, times, and proper attire for each event, are outlined below.

Eligibility for the Promotion Ceremony:

- > Students must pass their classes. Students who fail three semester courses (first and second semester combined) may not be able to participate in the Promotion Ceremony. Final deadline for grade verification will be Thursday, June 4th.
- > Students must complete their 12-hours of Community Service and Presentation. Twelve (12) hours of community service during the 2019-2020 academic year must be completed by Thursday, April 2nd. Students present twice--one during school on May 14th and the other that evening during Open House.
- ➤ All debts owed to the school must be cleared (Chromebook, overdue library books, lost/damaged textbooks, physical education locks, outstanding fees, musical instrument repairs, and/or borrowed materials) by 3:00 pm on Thursday, May 21st. We will only accept money orders or cash for debts.

End-of-the Year 8th Grade Activities

- May 15, 2020 (T.B.A.): Six Flags Magic Mountain rewards trip (less than 180 detention minutes)
- Students and LMS Staff spend the day away from school making memories at this popular amusement park. We will return to Lincoln around 8:00 p.m. Tentative cost is \$50.00 which includes all-day admission and transportation to the amusement park. Under state law and SMMUSD policy, a field trip is not authorized if any student would be excluded from participation because of lack of sufficient funds. - Friday, May 22nd: Baby Pictures due to Homebase teachers

 - Ties, sweaters, sport jackets or suits are optional
 - Inappropriate attire:
 - Formal gowns, tuxedos, t-shirts, shorts, or jeans.
 - o Students who do not follow the dress code or no limousine rule will not be permitted into the dance. Please see Mrs. Takahashi if you have any questions about attire.

- Friday, June 5th: Beach Day (less than 210 detention minutes)

 - Period 4-6 Onyx Core Practice while Jade Core attends Period 4-6 classes
- o Promotion invitations, including <u>3 tickets</u> to the Promotion Ceremony, will be distributed at the end of school.
- Unfortunately, there are no extra tickets. We recommend that you contact other families for unused tickets. There will be a waitlist at the entrance of the auditorium on the day of Promotion. Waitlisted guests will be admitted based on seating availability.

- Seating is on a first come, first served basis. Please do not block the aisles (Fire Code).
- o Balloons and such, that may block others' view of the stage, are not permitted in the auditorium. Pictures may be taken at the end of the ceremony on the grassy quad.
